

DISNEY AND POINTS OF LIGHT VOLUNTEER FAMILY OF THE YEAR JUDGING AND ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA

JUDGING CRITERIA

The following factors will be considered when judging applications:

Service (35%). How does the nominee family make the world a better place through creative, imaginative or otherwise extraordinary service to the community?

Inspiration (35%). Does the nominee family's story warm your heart, make you want to tell your friends about their story and inspire others to act?

Courageous Spirit and Teamwork (30%). When the nominee family learns of a community need, do they routinely go above and beyond as a team to answer the call for help? Does each member of the nominee family utilize their individual talents when coming together as a team united for good?

ELIGIBLITY CRITERIA

- 1. Must be legal U.S. residents.
- 2. Volunteer work must be associated with a U.S.-based nonprofit or school that meets <u>The Walt Disney Company Global Charitable Giving Guidelines</u>.
- 3. Nominee family must be nominated by a nonprofit or school that has registered to participate in the *Disney Family Volunteering Reward Program*.
- 4. Family must have participated in volunteer work together.
- 5. There must be at least one (1) individual who is at least 18 years old in the nominee family.
- 6. The nominee family can consist of a maximum of 10 individuals.
